a. Report: Matt Harris presented how DART started an initiative to incorporate art in a bus shelter. <b>SUBJECT:</b>	<b>VOLKAN ALKANOGLU SCULPTURE UPDATE</b>

On December 10, 2019, the Public Art Advisory Commission recommended Pleasant Hill City Council approve entering a contract with Volkan Alkanoglu to produce his sculpture, "Phoenix," to be placed in the roundabout at the intersection of NE 70<sup>th</sup> Street and Rising Sun Drive. The project is funded by a combination of grants, private donations, and city funds. The art was anticipated to be installed at the beginning of June.

Volkan Alkanoglu has contracted a manufacturing company in Denver, Colorado. Due to the pandemic, the State of Colorado stopped nonessential work, including the production of our City's first public art sculpture for several months. Manufacturing has begun and Alkanoglu is anticipating an early winter installation assuming weather agrees. Plans have been submitted and approved by the City Engineer and the City's building department. A foundation has been poured at the sculpture's location. A dedication ceremony is being developed in a responsible manner considering the ongoing pandemic and will become more concrete once dates of installation are verified.

Appropriate Commission action would be to listen to the update and ask questions pertaining to the sculpture installation.
