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1. CALL TO ORDER

- a. Presentation on Potential Updates to the City's Zoning Code – City Manager Ben Champ explained that the City Council has prioritized zoning ordinance updates and has been working on modifications with Confluence Landscape Architects for several years. Confluence Consultant Chris Shires presented proposed draft sign code updates recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission for Council to discuss and consider.
- b. Presentation from Central Iowa Water Trails – Mayor Sara Kurovski introduced Altoona Mayor Dean O'Connor, Hannah Inman, and Nikki Syverson to present a proposed 28E Agreement between Central Iowa Water Trails, Inc. and the Metro Municipalities to help activate 150 miles of waterways throughout the state.
