PLEASANT HILL, Iowa – December 15, 2015 – The Pleasant Hill Fire Department will recognize three individuals for their noble service to their fellow citizens on Thursday, December 17, 2015 at the Southeast Polk Community School District Board of Education meeting, beginning at 5:30 pm.

On October 28, 2015, three school district employees responded to a medical incident and provided first responder Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), and electrical defibrillation with the use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) to save a life. Their quick actions demonstrated the benefit of first responder training in CPR and AED.
