Phone Scam Alert

PLEASANT HILL, Iowa – February 19, 2016 – The Pleasant Hill Police Department has been made aware of a phone scam involving a male caller who identifies himself as an Internal Revenue Service (IRS) agent. According to the reporter, the male caller demands money from the victim or threatens the victim with arrest. The perpetrator instructs the victim to deposit money in an account to avoid arrest charges by the IRS.

The Pleasant Hill Police Department is actively investigating this case, but we want to advise anyone who receives a call like this to just hang up and contact police, never give out personal or financial information over the phone.
