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**City of Pleasant Hill Seeks Applicants for Public Arts Advisory Commission**

Pleasant Hill, Iowa — The City of Pleasant Hill is seeking applications for seven members to be appointed on the Public Arts Advisory Commission. These volunteers will help shape our city and assist in making decisions that impact the parks we play in, the roads we drive on, the neighborhoods we live in, and much more!

The Commission will play a vital role in advising and assisting the Pleasant Hill City Council in the promotion of public art and performing arts within the City's physical environment and public spaces. The City is seeking volunteers interested in and representing diverse backgrounds and perspectives of art and culture who are ready to further our connection with all forms of art. At least five members shall reside within Pleasant Hill. Members shall not hold any other elected or appointed office within Pleasant Hill City government.

Members will serve staggered terms of four years after the initial appointments. At the time of the initial appointment, the Mayor shall designate the length of term for each member. Three members will be appointed for two years and four members will be appointed for four years.
