## **UPDATE: Person Has Been Identified and Arrested** **Pleasant Hill Police Seek Public's Help to Identify Male in Dash Cam Video**

**PLEASANT HILL, Iowa** – On the morning of Wednesday, Sept. 28, Pleasant Hill Police were investigating a citizen's call regarding individuals breaking into vehicles in a Pleasant Hill neighborhood. When officers approached the subjects they ran. After relocating one of the individuals that ran, the officer inquired and found a change of clothing in his backpack and stolen property. The individual was identified as a juvenile male, was questioned, charged and later released.

The other individual was later identified as Tristin Tripp, 18. Pleasant Hill officers arrested Tripp in Des Moines and charged him with the following counts – two counts of interference with official acts, one count of carrying weapons, one count of providing false information to law enforcement, five counts of burglary in the third degree, and possession of stolen weapons. Tripp was later taken to Polk County jail. Tripp was positively identified as the individual from the dash cam footage previously released by the department.
