**Public Open House Unveiling Park Plans for the New 77-acre Park, Southeast of
Four Mile Elementary**

PLEASANT HILL, Iowa – On Wednesday, Nov. 9, 2016 an open house will be held to unveil the master plan for the 77-acre new park located southwest of Four Mile Elementary. The open house will take place from 4:30 to 6 p.m. at Doanes Park Youth Center, 5050 Doanes Park Road in Pleasant Hill.

The open house will feature information on the proposed amenities in the master plan for the new park; including trails, splash pad, dog park, soccer fields, open green space, and shelters.
