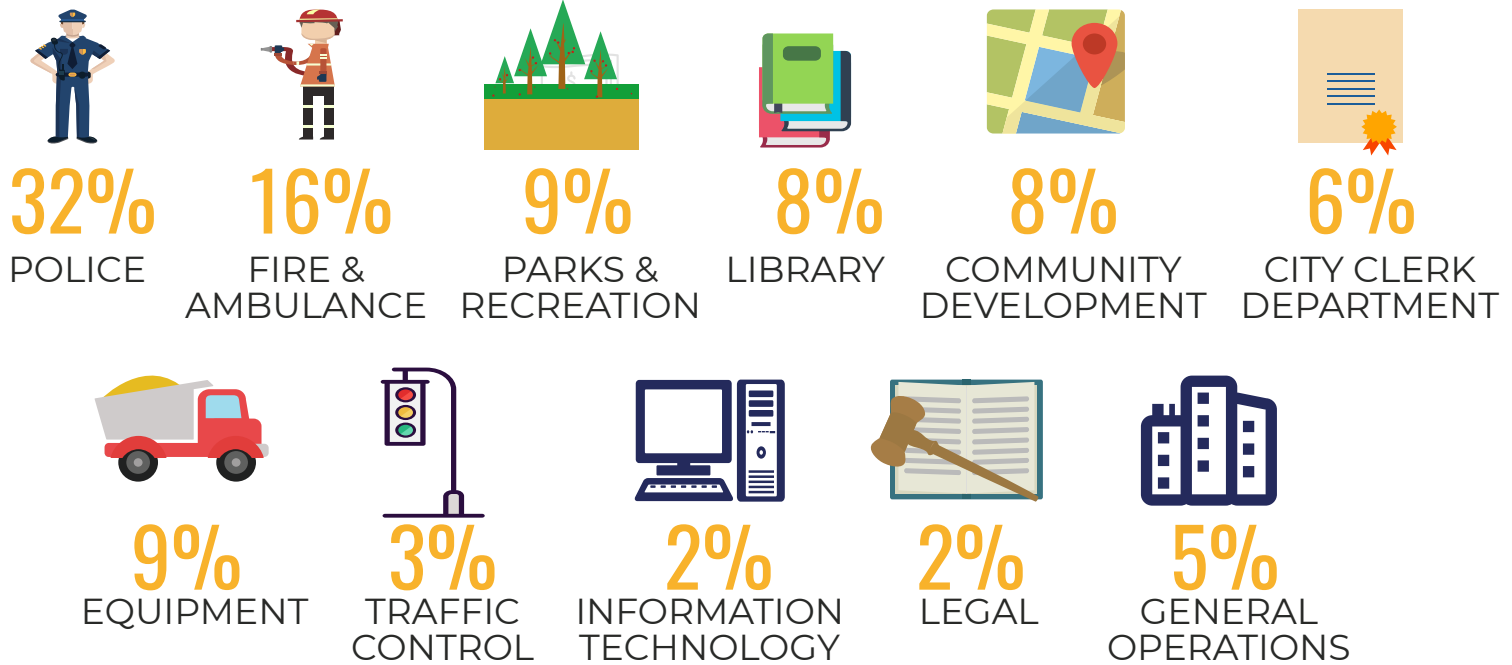

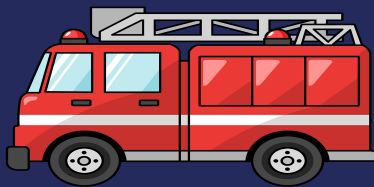

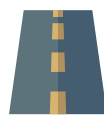


**New Streetsweeper to clean debris from streets and keep pollutants out of local waterways**
