Notification

A. The applicant shall notify the City in writing a minimum of five (5) working days prior to any application to the IDNR for release of any property from a General Permit #2 pursuant to 567 IAC 64.6(b), or any similar successor provision.

B. The Holder of the State NPDES General Permit #2 can transfer State NPDES General Permit #2 responsibility to new property owners. Transferees must agree to the transfer in writing, and must agree to fulfill all obligations of the SWPPP, and the State NPDES General Permit #2. Absent such written confirmation of transfer of obligations, the applicant remains responsible for compliance on any lot that has been sold. *Reference: Iowa Administrative Code, Section 567, Chapter 64.6, paragraph 6.*

C. The applicant shall be required to provide the following executed certification:

"As owner, I will ensure all topsoil preservation requirements stipulated by General Permit #2 are implemented on those sites for which they are required. **Written documentation of a soil survey completed by properly qualified personnel who regularly conduct soil surveys as part of their normal job duties shall be conducted prior to any soil disturbing activities and prior to acceptance of final plat and/or a Certificate of Occupancy being issued. The certifications must be provided to the City and in compliance with Iowa DNR General Permit #2.**"

At a minimum, the enforcement officer will perform quarterly inspections to review adequate site controls, weekly inspections and an updated SWPPP. The quarterly inspections will be performed until the City receives a copy of the Notice of Discontinuation by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources for NPDES General Permit #2. The enforcement officer shall conduct at least one unannounced inspection during the course of construction to monitor compliance with the State NPDES General Permit #2 and the City COSESCO Permit.

By signing this application, the permittee understands that:

- Perimeter controls must be in place prior to any soil disturbing activities.
- Construction site entrance that prevents off-site tracking is required.
- Concrete washout must be contained when washing out on site.
- Topsoil shall be placed in accordance with IDNR General Permit #2.
- This site must stay in compliance with NPDES General Permit #2 and the City of Pleasant Hill COSESCO Permit.
